## 2009 AA Baseball Rules

1. Any youth, who is seven years of age, as of August 1, 2002, and not older than 10, is eligible to participate in AA Baseball for the 2009 season.
2. AA Baseball will be coach pitched only; the pitching machine will not be utilized this year.
3. 10 players will be on the field for defense-four outfielders will be used.
4. The entire roster will bat. All players shall have a turn at bat.
5. Innings will follow the rule of 5/3; 5 runs or 3 outs, or any combination adding to 5 (which ever comes first).
6. Games will be 6 innings. If the weather becomes a factor in play, managers will decide how long the game will continue. No new innings shall be started after 100 minutes.
7. All players are to play equal time and are required to play the infield for a minimum of one inning.
8. The catcher will be the only player required to wear a cup, but is strongly encouraged for other players.
9. AA managers have the option to give players a chance to try pitching towards the end of the season. If managers want to do this, it will need to be a unanimous, division wide decision, and will be monitored closely. Please consult the baseball director.
10. Should the player pitch option be implemented, the pitcher will pitch 4 balls to each batter. If not the batter does not successfully hit them, then the coach shall step in and pitch to the batter.
11. An end of season tournament may be considered after the regular season has ended. Teams will be polled the near the end of the season.
